The anticipation of this exciting move is expressed by clients, staff, and guardians alike.

Improving efficiency and safety is always foremost in our planning. This year, we implemented electronic administration of medical records, making records available from anywhere. Our new program My25 promotes healthy eating and lifestyles for our clients. Both of these programs have been met with outstanding results.

The bedrock of Opportunity House and the bulk of our staff are our Direct Support Professionals, who are all incredibly dedicated to the welfare of our clients. Investing in and recognizing all our loyal and dedicated employees is our focus this year. We have provided some needed flexibility and options for our staff

Opportunity House is a nonprofit, community-sponsored organization whose mission is to help people with intellectual and developmental disabilities to work, live in homes of their choice and enjoy community life.

FY22 Accomplishments

- The Residential Program added two new homes to enhance and expand residential services.
- Electronic medical administration records (EMARs) were implemented in 7 of 9 residences for more efficient record-keeping.
- To allow more options and flexibility for our employees, When to Work, an online scheduling program, was implemented.
- DSPs began training with Relias, an online program that provides efficient and high-quality training.
- The Leadership Team developed an **Employee Incentive Plan** that will impact all employees.
- OH launched a College Tuition Reimbursement Plan to support our employees' educational goals.
- A **Diversity**, **Equity**, **Inclusion**, **and Belonging** (DEIB) Committee was initiated to create a better working environment.
- Together, we successfully completed the following accreditation and surveys:
 - ·Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF)
 - ·Bureau of Accreditation, Licensure, and Certification (BALC)
 - ·Bureau of Quality Management (BQM)
 - ·Real Estate Assessment Center (REAC)
 - ·Management of Risk (MOR)



Program Highlights

- OH Industries employed 64 clients and provided work for thirteen businesses in FY22. 94% of clients report being satisfied or very satisfied with their work experience.
- The re-energized Recreation Program had an exciting year under new leadership. Clients are focusing on health and wellness, meeting new people, and learning. Clients enjoyed trips to the Adler Planetarium and Tower Hill Stables, and interest in the activities continues to grow. This program is centered around fun!
- Special Olympics offered the full range of options for athletes this year: basketball, bocce, volleyball, soccer, golf, softball, and bowling. Basketball teams Thunder and Heat advanced to the state competition, bringing home the gold for OH! We hope to offer even more options to participate in team sports in the coming year.





- In Community Day Services, clients had more opportunities to volunteer with Meals on Wheels, Walnut Grove Farm, and DeKalb County Community Gardens. OH University and OH institute were developed to facilitate job exploration and offer meaningful classes.
- Two beautiful Sycamore homes were purchased for the Residential Program, and clients and staff are looking forward to moving in. We are fortunate to provide these resources to improve daily living for our clients
- Community Supports and Vocational Services worked together to enhance client experience in the community and at work.
 100% of employers reported satisfaction with OH services and support.




